

Rosanne Cash *Black Cadillac*

Following the recent deaths of her Father country icon **Johnny Cash**, Stepmother **June Carter Cash** and Mother **Vivian Liberto**, it is not surprising that a sense of loss has driven **Rosanne Cash** to produce her best ever songs.

Her latest release *Black Cadillac* is perhaps the most compelling album of her distinguished career.

With this album, Rosanne confronts her family legacy as never before, while pursuing her own bold, yet natural creativity.



Rosanne Cash is a Grammy-winning singer and songwriter. Her eleven record albums, released over the last twenty years, have charted eleven number-one singles. She has earned numerous accolades for her songwriting and performance.

Rosanne recorded her first US album, *Right Or Wrong*, in 1979. In the following 10 years, she released *Seven Year Ache*, which yielded both country and crossover hits, *Rhythm and Romance*, a widely-acclaimed fusion of country and pop and *King's Record Shop*, which generated four number one singles.

Rosanne Cash lives in New York City with her husband, John Leventhal, and her children.

After a rapturously-received series of UK and US live dates, **Rosanne Cash** is soon to appear in Australia at the Sydney Festival.

Catherine also performed at this year's incredibly successful Gympie Muster and she is expected to pick up several finalists spots in the **CMAA Country Music Awards of Australia**.

Her previous four singles (*Upside Of Being Down, Poor Man's Pride, Too Far Gone* and *Swingin' Door*) from the album all reached #1 on the CMC Top 30 Countdown and were also top 10 country radio hits.

Catherine's new album is expected to be released in the US and Australia in the second half of 2007.

Globe trotting to the Middle East to entertain the **Australian** troops and International Allied Forces was a significant experience for **Beccy Cole**. And yes, she's about to take off again.



Explore Holidays has signed high-profile country music star **Beccy Cole** to host a special 12-day/10-night country music tour to the June 2007 CMA Music Festival in Nashville, Tennessee.

One of the biggest names on the Australian country music scene and the current **Country Music Association of Australia's 'Entertainer of the Year'**, Beccy will play a major role in the tour which departs Australia on 01 June 2007.

Beccy will travel with the group and perform a private concert for all tour participants at a special breakfast banquet.

The main highlights of the 12-day tour comprise four days at the CMA Music Festival in Nashville and the chance to get up close to many of the performing artists.

These include Australia's own **Travis Collins** who will perform at a CMA Global Artists party.

The program also visits the famous Sun Studios where **Elvis Presley** recorded his first hit and his famous home, '**Graceland**' in Memphis.

The tour itinerary also includes visits to the Country Music Hall of Fame, a 'Grand Ole Opry' backstage tour, a factory outlets shopping tour, sightseeing tours of both Nashville and Memphis and lunch at the Casey Jones Complex at Jackson Tennessee.
