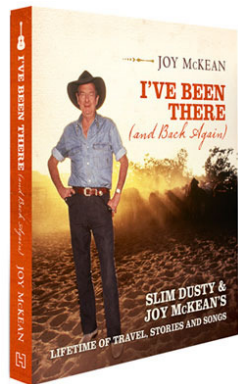

Did you know: Big Bopper J.P. Richardson wrote **George Jones' "White Lightning"** which became **Jones' first #1 country hit** in 1959? He also wrote **"Running Bear"** for **Johnny Preston**, his friend from Port Arthur, Texas.

Plot Summary:

Buddy joins **'The Winter Dance Party'** of 1959, a bus tour through the Midwest quenching the teenage thirst for the **'new music called Rock 'n' Roll'**. The tour is hard work, the weather conditions appalling and the performers are alternating between sleeping in the luggage racks and dropping into hospital to be treated for frostbite.

Our story ends on **February 3rd, 1959**, after a rocking concert with the **'Big Bopper' J.P. Richardson** and **Ritchie Valens** at the Surf Ballroom in Iowa. **Buddy** makes the fateful decision to break his promise to his pregnant wife not to fly, as he and the other two head-liners board a small plane and take off into the night destined for their next show. During a snow storm, in the dead of night, the plane crashes and spares no survivors.

The tragedy shocks the world, snatching the lives of three of the world's most dynamic musical talents - **Buddy Holly, Ritchie Valens and the Big Bopper**. **Buddy's** brief life is immortalised in this dynamic and heart-rending stage show. It's a celebration of the man, his music and life that catches that unique mixture of innocence, determination, humor and charm that was **Buddy Holly**...and the rest will just be Rock 'n' Roll.
