Nathaniel O'Brien, 9, of Burra, hopes to be the next big country music singer and he is well on the way of achieving his ambition.

Nathaniel has been singing for two years, following a strong family tradition with his dad, Danny, mum Karen and sister Tracey all having good voices and singing at the drop of a hat.

Nathaniel has won numerous awards and has come to the attention of such country greats as Beccy Cole - his idol with whom he hopes to perform with when she sings in Burra next year.

After winning several vocal competitions and Eisteddfods, Nathaniel most recently won the Len Wakefield Memorial award at the Champion of Champion competition at the South Australian Country Music Club - the youngest person to ever win this award.

As a result of his excellent performances in competitions, Nathaniel has won a recording package and he is now in the process of recording 'Dreams', an original song written for him by Danny Brian.

Nathaniel funds his entry to many of the festivals by collecting bottles and helping his dad collect wood from the scrub. Although still young, he has an angelic voice with beautiful vibrato and diction. Nathaniel is now learning to play the guitar so he can accompany himself and write music.

Bread and Butter Pudding

4 Slices of Bread and Butter
2oz Sultanas
1oz Sugar
500 mls Milk
2 Eggs Beaten
Nutmeg

Cut bread into strips, lay them in a well-buttered dish, buttered side up and sprinkle each layer with fruit and sugar. Don't use fruit on top layer. Heat milk and pour it on to the beaten eggs, strain it into the dish. Sprinkle on the nutmeg. Set aside for ½ hour to let the bread swell. Bake in a fairly hot oven for ½ hour until set and lightly browned.

Malt Loaf

12oz S/R Flour
3 Tbls Ovaltine
6oz Sugar
8oz Dried Fruit
2 Tbls Malt Extract
250 mls Milk
Grease a loaf pan, heat oven 160c
Dissolve malt in milk Mix all other ingredients together then add milk and malt. Mix well, pour into tin.
Bake for 1 ½ hours
