In April, **Beccy** will be joined by her friend, music star **Adam Harvey**. "He's the best in the business," she gushes. "Watching him entertain is thrilling. Singing with him is an honour."

Leo Sayer... You Make Me Feel Like Dancing... will be making a special guest appearance.

"I'm very lucky to have performed with **Leo** on a number of occasions," Beccy says. "He's the life of the party backstage, a very funny man who is always 'on'. He's also very generous to his fellow performers and clearly loves calling **Australia home**."

Harmony Impresses APRA



Hard work and self-funding is beginning to pay off for rising **country music** star **Harmony James**.

The **Brisbane** singer has so far paid for everything to pursue her musical dreams and struggled at times despite her single **Somebody Stole My Horse** topping the country charts in 2008.

Harmony was recently offered a lifeline worth \$25,000 when she was named among eight aspiring artists to receive a professional development award from the **Australasian Performing Right Association (APRA)** at a presentation in Sydney. **Harmony** says the bi-annual awards from APRA represented a significant boost for Australian musicians trying to make their career in an often unforgiving industry.

"Being an independent artist things are always a bit tight.... This will just hurry things up a bit by a couple of years and allow me to do things I would've otherwise have had to save up for."

Top of the list is spending some time recording in Sydney with Australia's top country music talent before travelling to Nashville to showcase her talents and develop her song writing career.

In 2009 **Harmony** was awarded **Female Vocalist Of The Year** and the **Southern Stars** awards and a year later she was nominated for the **2010 CMAA Album of the Year and Female Artist of the Year**.

Having released and marketed her own EP and debut album, **Harmony** became a unanimous choice for a grant by APRA's judges after being selected from around 2500 entries. **Well done Harmony. You're a rising star in progress!**
