On the couch.... Naked.

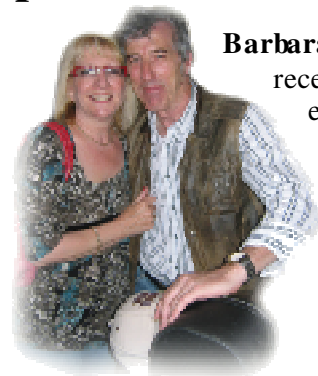
Experience Counts

"Have you had any actual experience in picking lemons?"**

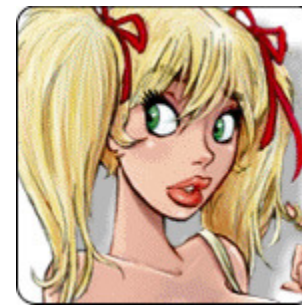
**"Well, as a matter of fact, I have!"

I'm retired - Go around me!

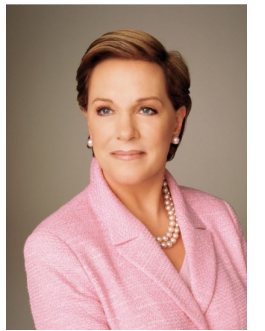
